UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION - ONE WITH THE HORSE

There are certain circumstances where your horse must be enrolled in the Horse Recording Program (please see below). You can use this opportunity to register your horse either for one year or for life, **please select one of the following options** but note that for a competition requiring a passport you must select the lifetime registration option.

A. HORSE RECORDING - Please use this section to register a new horse for the purpose of participating in any of the following programs:

1. USEF Awards and Championship programs including the Farnam®/Platform™ USEF Horse of the Year Program.
2. Any FEI competition (where a passport is required).
3. USEF/USDF Qualifying and Championship Classes and USEF National Championships for Dressage (see DR127).
4. Any jumper division which offers classes where \$2500 or more is offered in prize money (GR 1102.3).

- Please note that the name a horse or pony is registered under must be the exact name that horse or pony will compete under at USEF-recognized competitions.

- This recording becomes effective on the date that these materials and fees are received by the USEF office (exception: GR1110).

- The horse or pony must be recorded on or before the starting date of the competition for the points to count. Points will not be credited retroactively (see GR 1110) so please be sure that the owner of the horse or pony is an active Platinum, Senior, Junior or Life member. If the horse is owned by a farm, partnership, corporation or syndicate, please make sure that the entity is on record as a "farm" registration and at least one owner falls into one of the membership categories listed above.

LIFETIME RECORDING OF THE HORSE/PONY

If you are selecting an age discount, please provide proof of age.

- a. \$35 from birth until December 31st of year foaled.
- b. \$85 for horses one year of age (from January 1st until December 31st of the first year after foaling).
- c. \$160 for horses two years of age (from January 1st to December 31st of the second year of foaling).
- d. \$200 for horses three years of age or older.

\$75 ANNUAL RECORDING (expires November 30). If your horse or pony is being renewed under new ownership please be sure to submit a bill of sale.

All horses must have a Horse ID number to compete in a USEF-recognized competition.

B. HORSE ID NUMBER – Please use this option if you DO NOT want your horse to be eligible for USEF Awards and Championship Programs but want to compete in USEF licensed competitions (except those activities enumerated in GR901). This identification number must be provided on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Horses with an existing USEF Life or Annual Recording number (see section above) do not need to apply for an additional Horse ID number.
